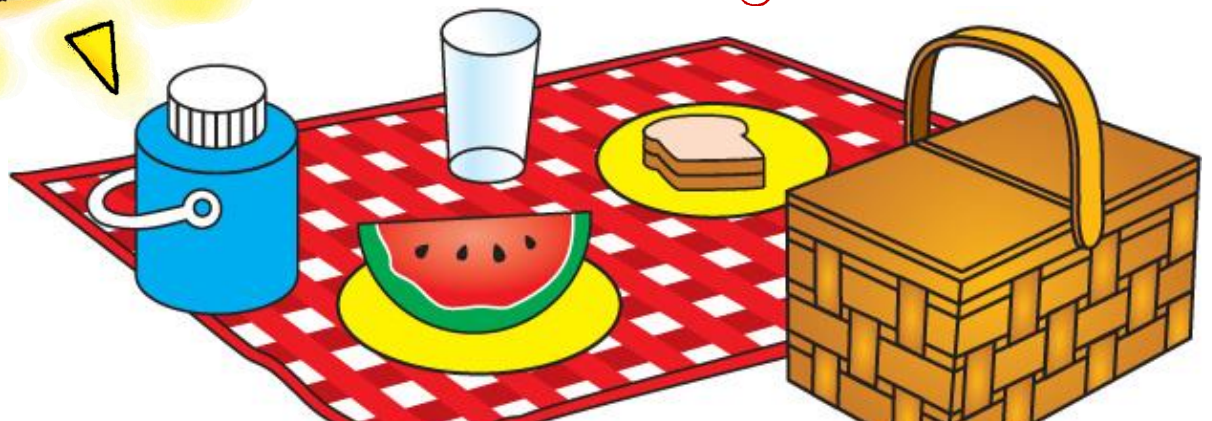

Year 1 – Fire Crew Visit

On Tuesday 16th May, Year 1 were very lucky to have the fire crew come and visit. The day started with a talk to all of us about fire safety in our homes. We learnt lots of facts and were shown what firefighters wear. They told us we should make our grown-ups test our fire alarms at home at least once a week! Our two visitors were called Karen and Sandra and they were very interesting to listen to and also very funny! After our session together as a year group, we went off into our classes where we had 3 different activities set up for us.

The first activity was a story about fire safety that was read to us and we had to join in and answer questions. This was great fun as it really got us thinking!

The second activity was a game a bit like snakes and ladders where we had to work together as a team (as that's what firefighters do) and roll the dice to work our way around the board. If we landed on a picture of a hedgehog we had to answer a question about road safety. If we landed on a picture of a flame we had to answer a question about fire safety. If we landed at the bottom of the ladder we could climb up it and finally, if we landed on a hose pipe we had to slide down it. It was such a good game and really made us work together and use our collaboration muscle!

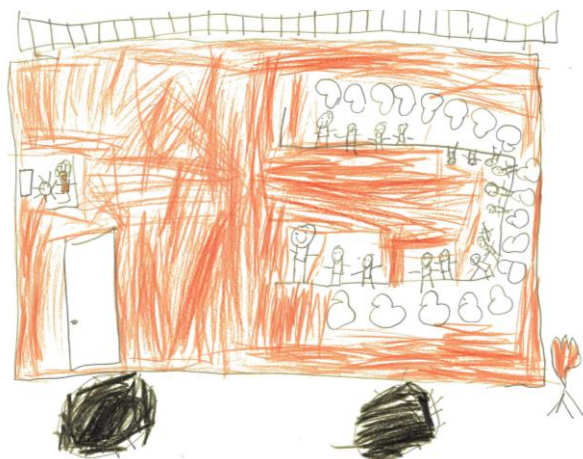
The third activity was the chance to go and see a real fire engine! We had to put our tunics on (we learnt that this is the name for the jackets that firefighters wear) and then we went outside onto the playground to see the fire engine. We were extremely lucky because we got to sit inside, put a helmet on and learn about all of the different things that a fire engine does. After that we even had a go at using the big water hose to put out a pretend fire. It was such good fun! Karen and Sandra both got us all wet too!

Everybody – the children and the grown-ups thoroughly enjoyed our day and have learnt lots of information about fire safety!

The class with the highest number of children with 100% was 3ER who had 16 children – well done!



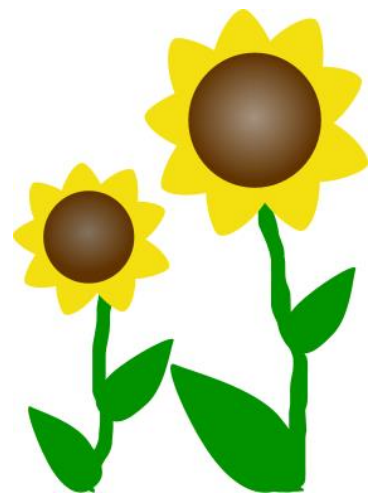
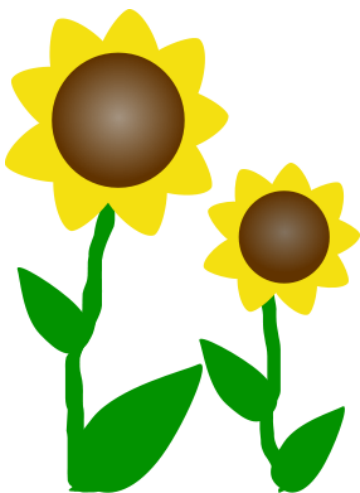
Year 6 Important Date!
