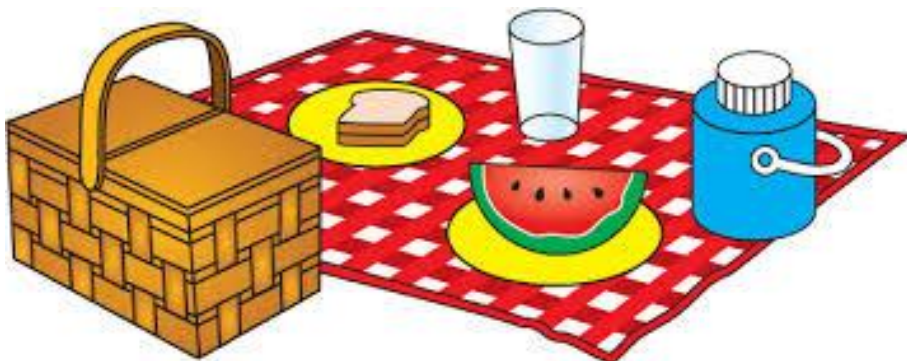

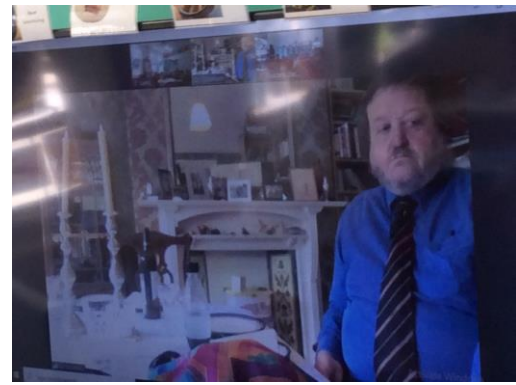




# Year 1 - RE + SCARF

# Year 1 - Marwell Trip

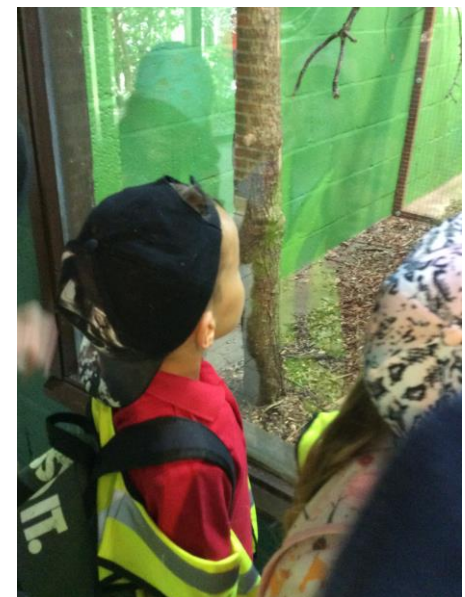
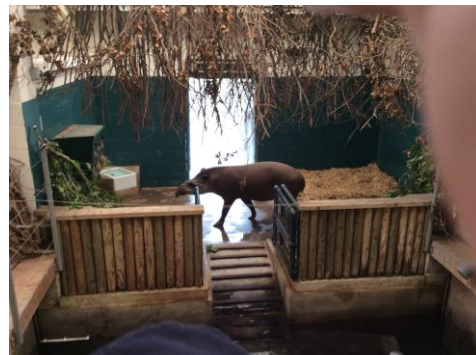
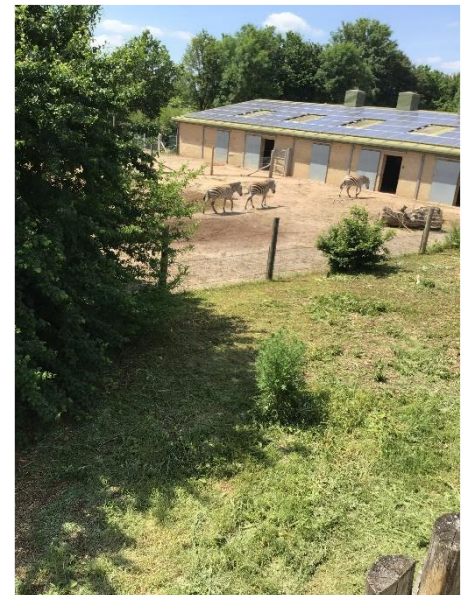

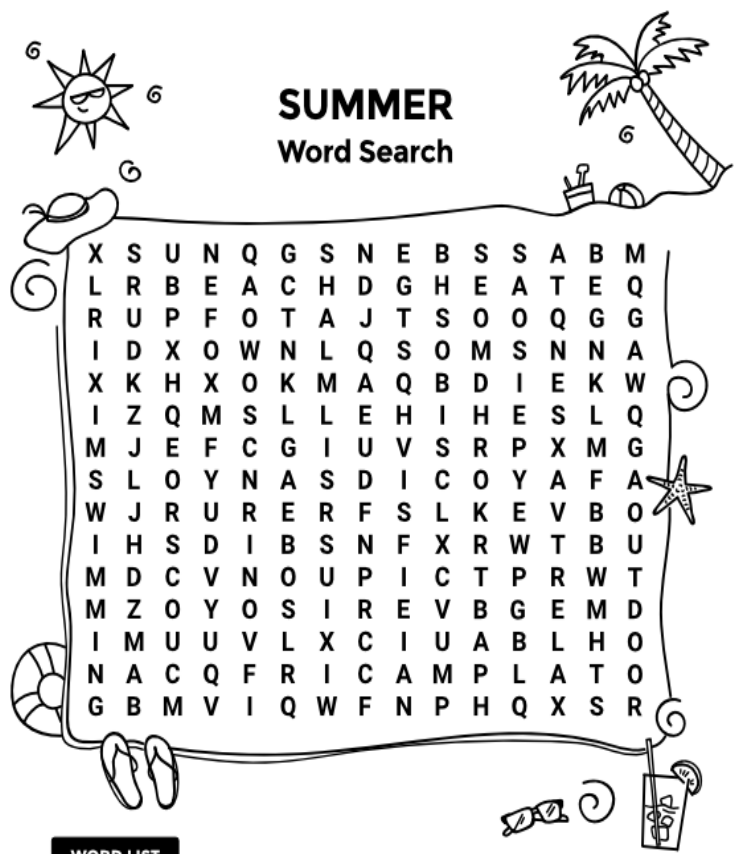
