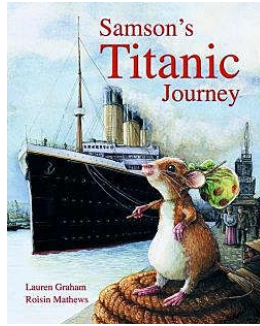


Year 2 Spring 1

What takes us on a journey?

In English this term we will continue to develop our writing skills. We will be exploring a range of texts including Samson's Titanic Journey, which links to our enquiry question. From this, we will be writing some personal accounts from different perspectives. In addition, we will be writing a recount of our personal experiences from our trip to the Titanic museum.



In Computing, we will be recording our finger puppets on a green screen background of the Titanic to read our personal accounts, written in English.



In History, we will be learning about the Titanic and recognising that it was a historical event beyond living memory. We will be looking at the Titanic on a historical timeline and exploring a range of sources to make comparisons on how life is different now compared to in this period of time.



In Maths, we will be starting multiplication and division. This will be developed through an understanding of equal groups and repeated addition. There will be a big focus on 2,5 and 10 times tables as this will support our learning. We will be drawing arrays, sharing and grouping to support the learning of



In RE, we will be focusing on 'People Jesus met' with a focus on change. We will be exploring why Christians believe that Jesus changes some people's lives.



P4C will be taught weekly to develop deeper thinking linked to our concepts of choice, hopes & dreams, empathy, and equality.



In Art, we will be exploring Phillip Tracey and August Macke's work. We will be taking inspiration from them and the Titanic to design and make our own hats using a range of materials and techniques when joining and making.



In PE, we will continue to follow the Real PE programme, developing our personal skills and teamwork through physical exercise. We will focus on both static and dynamic balance, and will be doing exercises that support the children in developing their cognitive skills.
