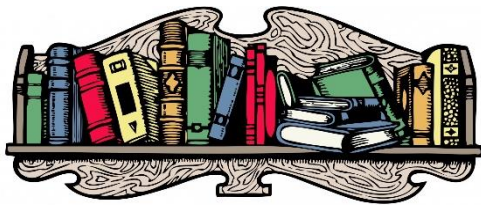

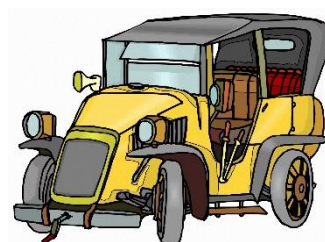
# Year 1 - Beaulieu Motor Museum

All the children impressed us so much with their enthusiasm, their listening and their excellent behaviour.

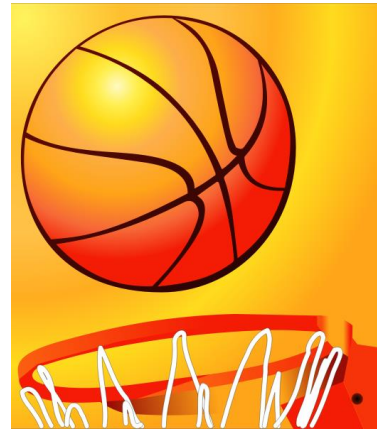

The girls were a credit to our school, well done girls.

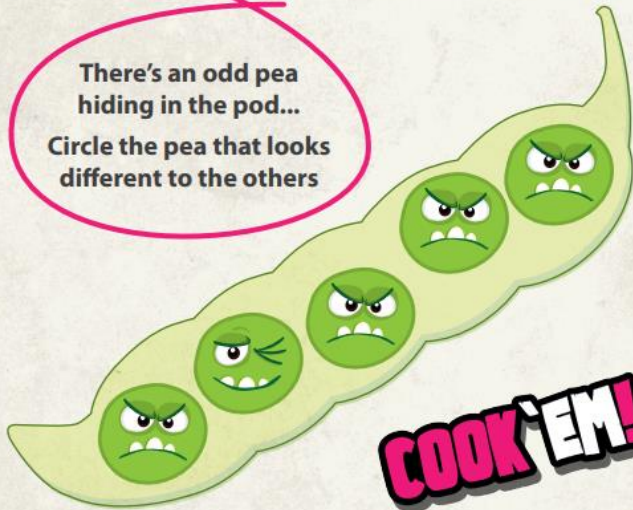

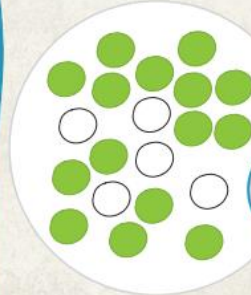

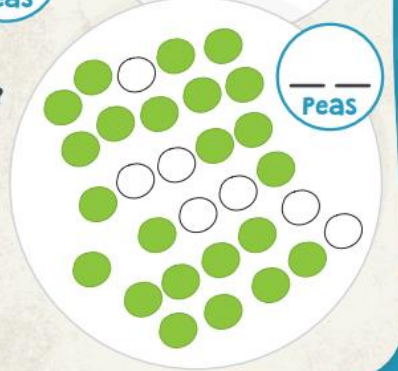

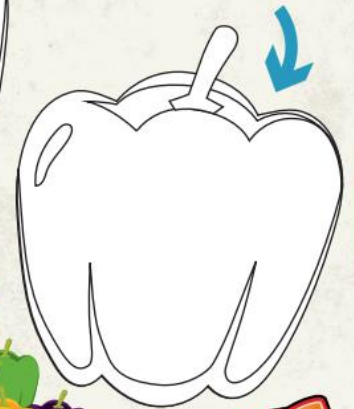
