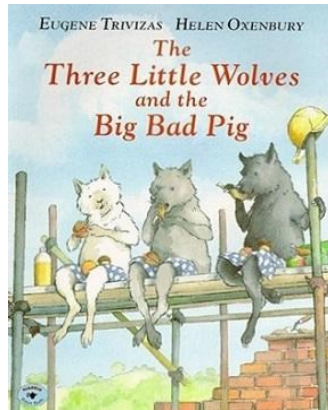


Year 2 Summer 1

What makes a hero?

In English this term we will be exploring traditional and twisted tales with a focus on the 'heroes' within the texts. The children will generate ideas through a range of stimuli and activities. This will support them in producing character descriptions, diary entries and narrative writing.



In Maths, we will be working on telling the time. This will include O'clock, half past, Quarter past/to and 5 minute intervals. In addition, we will also be focusing on length and height which will include comparing, measuring and ordering lengths. There will also be a focus on word problems using a range of skills.



In Science, we will be learning about plants. This will include observing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants and explore how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy. This will be done through a range of experiments.



In PE, we will continue to follow the Real PE programme, developing our personal skills and teamwork through physical exercise. We will focus on both static and dynamic balance, and will be doing exercises that support the children in developing their cognitive skills.



In RE, we will be focusing on the concept of authority in the Bible. This will be achieved through developing an ability to understand and appreciate the viewpoints of others.



P4C will be taught fortnightly to develop deeper thinking linked to our concepts of judgement, truth, service and identity.



Our music unit for this half term is called, Let's be Superheroes! We will be focusing on the musical dimensions of pitch and duration. We will begin to map pitch with signs and drawings and will rehearse playing glockenspiels. We will sing some superhero-songs and compose and notate our own rhythm patterns to illustrate heroic qualities.
