I was lucky enough to attend the Houses of Parliament and Globe Theatre Trip with Year 6 - the children met Baroness Crawley who was able to talk to the children in depth about her role in passing laws. I was so proud of the questions the children asked - they were thoughtful and showed some really deep thinking. The children were excellent role models for our school throughout the day. We got to visit both the House of Lords and House of Commons, as well as standing in the exact place Nelson Mandela stood whilst giving his speech in the great hall.




