The end of term is upon us and what a term it has been!

We have been working really hard this term to devise a system of monitoring attendance that keeps parents and carers informed of their child's attendance - and I think we are nearly there. Our approach to attendance management is based on prevention, early intervention and targeted support. Our aim is to be transparent in our monitoring for all families. We start monitoring attendance when it falls below the 95% mark, this is usually due to illness. A letter is sent out to alert parents that attendance has hit this threshold. When attendance falls below 90%, children are deemed as persistently absent. At this point, parents would have received previous letters alerting them to our concerns. In some cases, parents would have been asked to provide medical evidence for their children, due to high levels of absence relating to illness. It is clear in our policy we do not authorise any holidays in term time. If you need any support in getting your child to school, please do not hesitate to get in touch. Currently our whole school attendance stands at 95.6% compared to 93.7% nationally - our aim is to get our whole school attendance up to 97% by the end of the school year.

During the first half of next term we have Key Stage 1 and 2 SATS.

Key Stage 2 SATS week starts 9th- 12th May. Year 6 pupils will still be working towards their writing judgement up until the end of June, when County moderation is completed.

Key Stage One SATs start the week beginning the 15th May.

Year One and Two phonic assessments take place in June, as does the Year 4 multiplication check.

We are still awaiting our OFSTED report - so will get this to you as soon as it arrives.

Thank you to all parents who responded to the questionnaire, sent in chocolate supplies or just smiled at us on the gate!

Corridors are looking so much clearer since we moved to book bags, please remember you can pick up a book bag at reception (awaiting delivery). We've noticed some brilliantly accessorised book bags too!

Friends of Shamblehurst continue to be amazing and have recently donated money to fund IPADS to support music provision in school - we are hugely grateful for all their hard work. We say goodbye to Mrs Curtis and Miss McDougall at the end of this term and wish them bot the very best for the future. We welcome Mrs Nicola Smith, who is the new class teacher for Caterpillars.

Lastly, all staff wish our families a peaceful and relaxing Easter break and we look forward to seeing you on Monday 17th April 2023.
