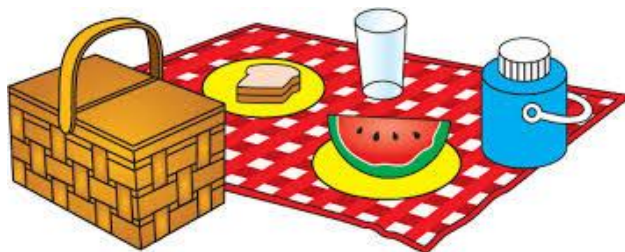

Year 1 - Marwell Zoo Trip

On Tuesday 13th June, Year 1 went on a trip to Marwell Zoo. The purpose of the trip was to think further about our enquiry question 'Should Zoos Exist?' We spent the day enjoying the zoo and seeing lots of different animals including mammals, birds, fish, reptiles and amphibians... the animal classification groups we have been learning about in school. Toucan Class got to see the meerkats up close which was the animal they have been learning about in school. For Lemur Class, it was the beautiful okapi and we were so lucky with a really close up view.

We talked about the animal enclosures and whether we felt they were providing enough space, shelter, shade and things to do for the animals. All of the children and staff has a brilliant, albeit slightly hot day! They were so well behaved, respecting the environment and the animals.

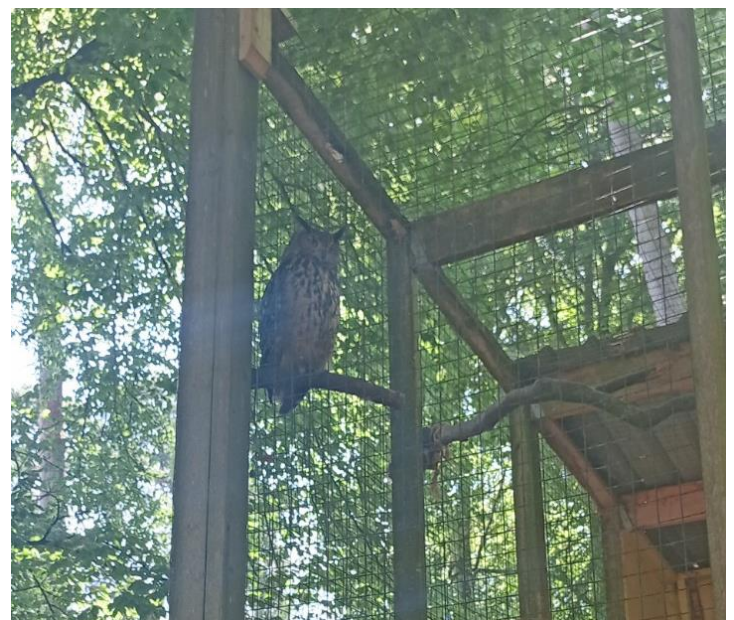

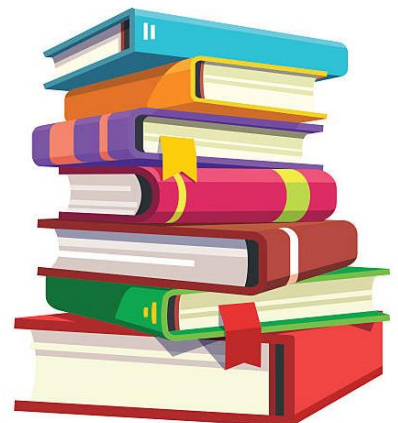
We realise that times are tough at the moment but hope that you will be able to help your children's voice at school with this venture.

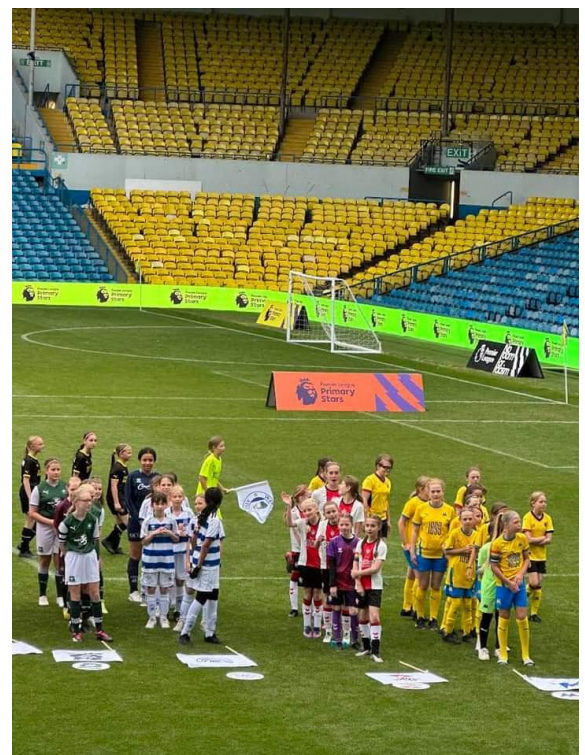
Congratulations to our girls' football team!

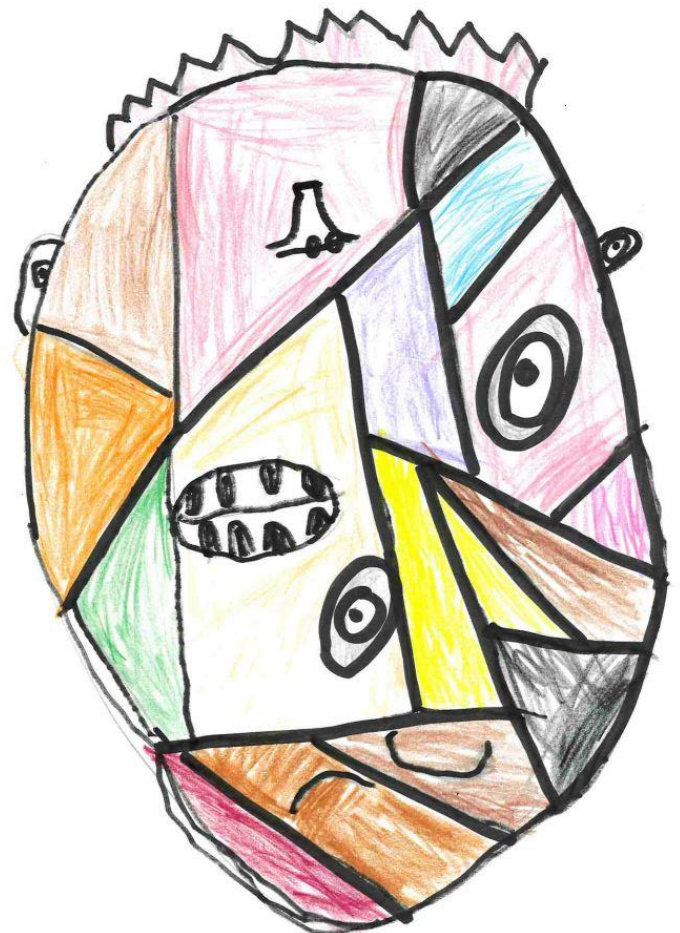

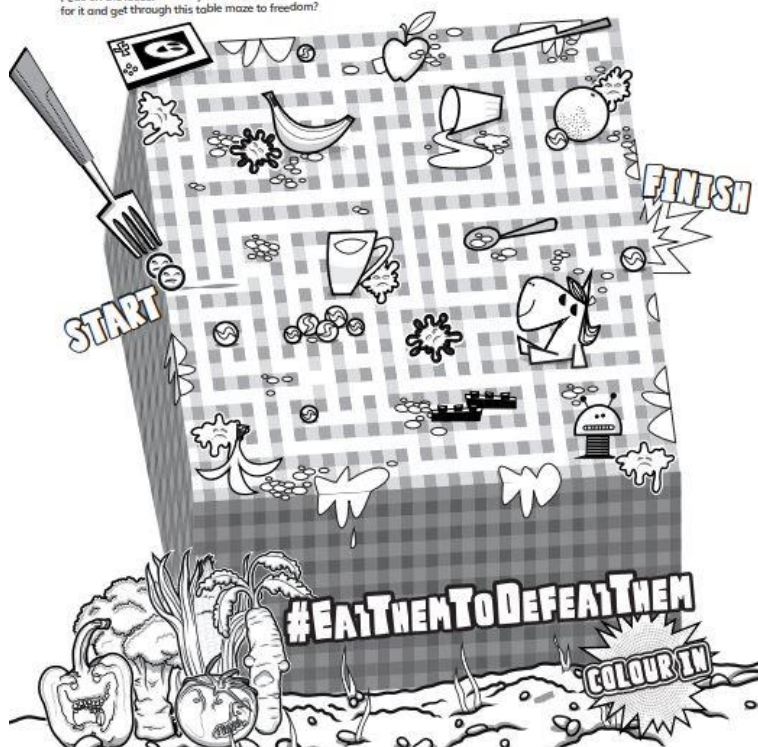

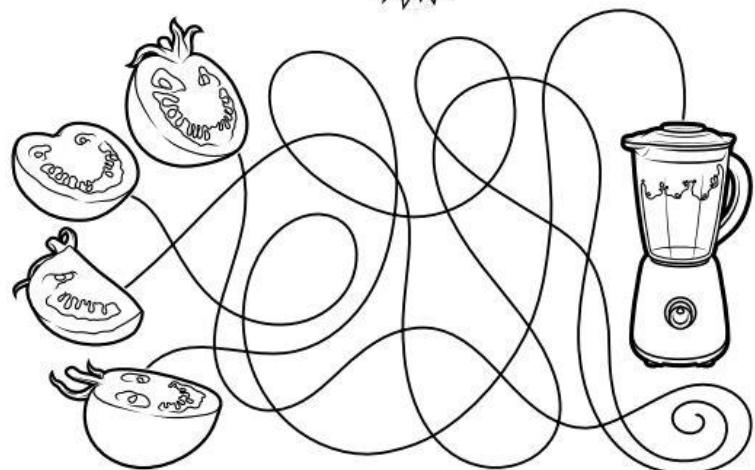
