






Well, we are fast approaching the last two weeks of term. We have still got lots of exciting learning to complete, including some fantastic authentic outcomes to round off year group enquiries.

We recently sent our attendance letters to the parents and carers of children whose attendance has fallen below 95% and 90%. It is important that we monitor attendance and this is set out in our attendance policy. We endeavour to work with all our families on a one-to- one basis, so please do ask for support if you are struggling getting your child in to school for whatever reason. For many families, these letters are simply for information, we totally understand children have periods of being poorly. However, in some cases, high levels of unexplained illness, holidays and lateness are having a huge impact on a child's attendance and this, in turn, has a huge impact on the social and emotional health of a child, as well as having an impact on academic progress.

Our attendance figures last week, showed that as a school, we were below the National Average for primary schools – this is really worrying, especially as we are not experiencing any major rise in illness.

In line with our policy, holidays will not be authorised and could lead to legal intervention or a penalty notice.

This is the case in all schools.



As communicated a few weeks ago, our amazing SENDCo, Mrs Burrell, is leaving to take up a post in a local Hampshire school. The SENDCo role will be taken on by Miss Edwards and Mrs Wright. Mrs Wright, has started her maternity leave this week, so Miss Edwards will be supported by myself and Mrs Mohamed until she returns. We endeavour to continue to maintain the high standards that Mrs Burrell has modelled. Please do contact us if you require any support or have any concerns.

### Year 1 - Gurdwara Trip

On Wednesday 15th November 2023 Year 1 visited the Singh Sabha Gurdwara in Southampton. In R.E Year 1 have been thinking about the concept of 'Special '. We began by thinking about what 'special ' means and then went on to think about and share our own special books and why they were special to us. We then began to learn about the special book within the Sikh Faith which is called the 'Guru Granth Sahib '. The Guru Granth Sahib is believed by Sikhs to be the last Guru ... Guru meaning teacher. It is considered to be so special that it has its own special bedroom where it is kept. When we arrived at the Gurdwara, we covered our heads, removed our shoes and washed our hands as a mark of respect. We went to the prayer hall where we saw the Guru Granth Sahib. We were so fortunate to see the special book being read by a gentlemen and seeing it in real life really made us understand just how special this book is. After that we went to the community kitchen within the Gurdwara. The langar is a free kitchen in Sikhism that offers vegetarian food to anyone who visits the gurdwara, regardless of their faith. It is a symbol of the oneness of humanity and the respect for the Guru Granth Sahib.

We all enjoyed rice and dahl. Some of the key values of Sikhism are community, equality and respect. We want to thank everyone at the Gurdwara for their kindness and generosity to us.

We are very proud of the Year 1 children and how sensible and respectful they were throughout our visit.
