


We have had a brilliant transition day in school this week. All children seemed relaxed and happy, and were really engaged in their learning. This year we have chosen three picture books as our stimuli –


Year 1 and 2 are using

These should be plain. Children should not wear football kits on PE days, nor should they wear designer tracksuits. We are incredibly inclusive and our uniform is very simple, so as to not impact those children with additional sensory needs. Please can we ask for support on this.

We continue to ask that children only bring in their book bags to school. Book bags are available in the office. For our Year 6 leavers, if you have any pre-loved uniform you would like to donate to the school, we would be very grateful.

### Year I - Raptor X-Otics

Year 1 enjoyed a visit from Dave Sharpe - Raptor X-Otics. He bought different animals for us to observe, touch and hold to help us further our learning on our enquiry "Should | Zoos Exist?" he bought animals from different animal classification groups including an owl, a python, a hedgehog, a giant African land snail and a crested gecko. He talked to us about responsibility and sustainability and how zoos can help to protect species that are endangered or close to extinction.

All the children were excited and curious, asking some fantastic questions. After the visit, Year 1 did some fantastic non-fiction, factual writing about what they had learned.
