This year is simply flying by - it is hard to believe we only have one term left and that are Year 6 pupils are nearing the end of their journey with us.

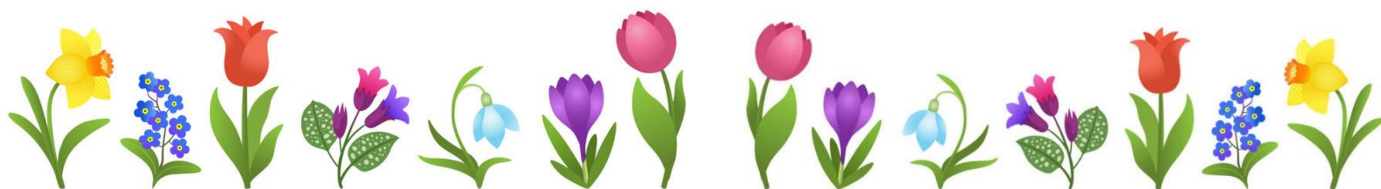
