
Curriculum Letter Year 3

Summer — 2025





Maths

In Maths this term, we are starting with recapping fractions and looking at how to simply add and subtract them, and work out fractions problems. We will then move on to

looking at money, solving problems adding and subtracting different amounts of coins. Just before half term, we will be starting our unit on Time, which involves telling the time using both analogue and digital clocks to the nearest minute. Towards the end of term, we will be moving on to units of Shape and Statistics. Times table knowledge will continue to be a focus weekly, please practise these as often as you can.

Our **Enquiry question** for this term is:

'Are we doing right by mother Nature?'

This will focus on the concepts of beauty, sustainability, responsibility and thrive to steer our learning.

We will be learning about:

- Science— As biologists, we will be learning about plants and looking at their parts and their functions. We will be planting our own plants and investigation how we can support plants to grow. As physicians, we will be learning about light and reflection.
- Geography—We will be looking at our local area. We will be doing field work to evaluate what the residents of Hedge end can do to support mother nature.
- Art
 — we will be looking at the artist Giuseppe and using his work to inspire our own food art.

Homework

Children will be bringing home a workbook to complete which will be set on a Thursday and expected in the following Tuesday. It will then be marked in class altogether. English/ Reading

In English, we will be looking at the texts - WALL-E, the Great Kapok tree, It Starts With a

Seed, The Secret Garden and The Curious Garden. We will develop our grammar skills of 2 a sentences, inverted commas and fronted adverbials to write setting descriptions, persuasive letters and narratives for different audiences. Reading will focus on retrieval, inference and fluency linked to our text drivers.

This term, we will be learning to play recorders! To deepen our understanding of timbre, we will listen to music played on a variety of woodwind instruments (as this is the family that recorders belong to). We will focus on pitch, starting by learning the fingering and musical notation for the notes B, A and G. We will learn to play with careful tonguing and breathing so that we can produce an increasingly clear tone quality and avoid any little squeaks!
