



Year 2 Summer

Are things always as they seem?

In English this term we will be exploring traditional and twisted tales. The children will generate ideas through a range of stimuli and activities. This will support them in producing character descriptions, diary entries and narrative writing.



In Maths, we will be focusing on length and height which will include comparing, measuring and ordering lengths. There will also be a focus on word problems using a range of skills. In addition, we will be exploring a range of tables including pictograms. We will be learning how to interpret and read the data.



In Geography, we will be focusing on identifying the characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas. We will be exploring the physical and human features of each country, along with their flags and famous landmarks.



In PE, our unit will be on 'invasion games'. We will learn different skills such as dodging, intercepting, passing, attacking and defending. Working as a team and competitive skills. Later in the term we will be focussing on 'multi skills'. This will also prepare us for Sports Day later in the term.



In RE, we will be focusing on the concept of authority in the Bible. This will be achieved through developing an ability to understand and appreciate the viewpoints of others. We will be learning about communities for Sikhi faith and how we look after others.



In Science we will learning about plants. We will investigate plants, bulbs and seeds. What they need to grow and survive. We will also be thinking about wildlife. What wildlife can do for us and what we can do for wildlife.



P4C, Let's Think and No outsiders will be taught weekly on a rotation. These help to develop deeper thinking and questioning skills.
