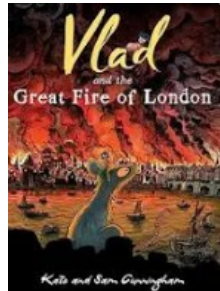
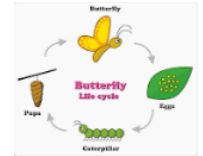


# Year 2 Summer

In English this term we will continue to develop our writing skills. We will be exploring a range of texts including Vlad and The Great Fire of London which links to our historical learning. From this, we will be writing some personal accounts from different perspectives. We will write a diary entry and a newspaper article.



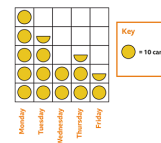
In Science we will continue our learning about plants. We will investigate plants, bulbs and seeds. What they need to grow and survive. We will also be thinking about wildlife. What wildlife can do for us and what we can do for wildlife. We will also be learning about different animal life-cycles.



In History, we will be learning about The Great Fire of London, recognising that it was a historical event beyond living memory. We will be visiting Weald and Downland Museum where we will see and explore real Tudor houses and take part in 'Fire in the bakehouse' workshop.



In Maths, we will be focusing on length and height which will include comparing, measuring and ordering lengths. There will also be a focus on word problems using a range of skills. In addition, we will be exploring a range of tables including pictograms. We will be learning how to interpret and read the data.



In RE, we will be focusing on the concept of authority in the Bible. This will be achieved through developing an ability to understand and appreciate the viewpoints of others. We will be learning about communities for Sikhi faith and how we look after others.



In Design and Technology we will be making a house with a hinge that is historically accurate (Tudor). We will also be creating a moving picture of a scene linked to The Great Fire of London.
