At the end of March, Year 2 had a Titanic Day in school. Children came to school dressed as either first- or third-class passengers, we even had some boilermakers and captains! We spent the morning learning 2 Irish dances. After break we performed our dances to the Year 1 children. We also did a hat parade with the wonderful hats we made during our art learning, inspired by the milliner Philip Treacy.

After lunch we had some refreshments. Depending on which class of passenger we were, we either had flutes of champagne (lemonade!!) or mugs of water! We learned some Morse Code and had fun writing messages for our friends to crack the code. It was a really fun day that helped to embed all of our learning about Titanic. Thank you to parents and carers for supporting the children with their costumes on the day.

Year 2 - Weald and Downland Museum Trip

Year 2 went on a fabulous trip to the Weald and Downland Museum to further our learning about The Great Fire of London. We took part in two workshops. One was fire lighting where we all tried to use flint and stone and also a fire lighter to create a spark. The other was to make bread in the bakehouse. After lunch, we had time to explore the site. We explored some Tudor houses, looking carefully at the features. The houses were made of wood, they had very small windows, many without glass. The furniture in the rooms was all wooden, with straw mattresses.... no wonder the fire spread so quickly!! Everyone had a fantastic day and the staff mentioned on a couple of occasions how well behaved and knowledgeable the children were. We were really proud of all the children.

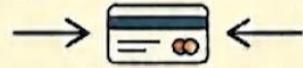
